Ticketing Terms & Conditions

Terms and Conditions

1. Tickets are issued subject to the rules and regulations of NWCFL & The Football Association in respect of the relevant competition and Sandbach United FC. Ground Regulations.
2. No person may bring into the Stadium or use within the Stadium any equipment which is capable of recording or transmitting (by digital or other means) any audio, visual or audio-visual material or any information or data in relation to a match or the Stadium.
3. Mobile telephones are permitted within the Stadium provided that they are used for personal and private use only.
4. The use of a match ticket to enter the Stadium constitutes acceptance of such rules and regulations and the Ground Regulations and Sandbach United FC. reserves the right to eject from the Stadium any person who fails to comply with such rules and regulations.
5. Season tickets are only valid for NWCFL League games & Pre-season friendlies, cup games and potential play off matches are NOT included.
6. Dates and times of kick-off will be announced on the club's Official and NWCFL Website and may be altered at short notice. It is the responsibility of the ticket holder to ascertain the date of any postponed or re-arranged matches.

7. The club cannot, under any circumstances, accept responsibility whatsoever for season ticket cards lost, damaged or stolen and an administration fee of £5 will be charged to replace the card.
8. Season ticket cards must be available for inspection at any time.
9. Season tickets are non-transferable.
10. All persons (including children) must have a valid card or ticket when entering the Ground.
11. Sandbach United FC is committed to equality and diversity and it is important that all of our fans share the Club's principles of inclusion.
12. We require all Season Ticket Holders to refrain from engaging in any conduct which is racist, homophobic or abusive and to refrain from any other discriminatory behaviour, including but not limited to discriminatory behaviour in relation to the following characteristics: age; disability; gender reassignment; marriage and civil partnership; pregnancy and maternity; race; religion or belief; sex; and sexual orientation.
13. Season Ticket Holders who engage in any of the behaviours set out at clause 12 may:
 - be subject to actions taken in accordance with Club policies on anti-discrimination as stated on the Club's website.
 - be refused entry to or evicted from the Ground.
 - have their Season Ticket cancelled or withdrawn, without refund.
 - be suspended or banned from entering the Ground on future occasions; and/or
 - be subject to prosecution in accordance with law.
17. Season tickets are non-refundable. Any refunds that are issued are done so entirely at the discretion of the club. Refund values will be calculated on a pro-rata basis based on the casual ticket value.
18. No alcohol will be permitted into the ground, if found in possession of alcohol it will be confiscated.
19. 10% off purchases from The CrossBar is valid from 13:00 until 1 hour after the final whistle on Saturdays and from 18:00 until 1 hour after the final whistle at mid-week fixtures.
