

Sponsorship Application — Terms and Conditions

1. Eligibility

- 1.1 Applicants must be based in the United Kingdom unless otherwise agreed in writing.
- 1.2 Applicants must demonstrate that the sponsorship aligns with the charitable objectives of Sandbach United Football Club CIO.
- 1.3 The charity reserves the right to refuse any application at its sole discretion.

2. Application Process

- 2.1 Submission of an application does not guarantee sponsorship.
- 2.2 All information provided must be accurate and complete to the best of the applicant's knowledge.
- 2.3 The charity may request additional documentation or clarification before making a decision.

3. Use of Sponsorship Funds or Support

- 3.1 Sponsorship must only be used for the purposes described in the approved application.
- 3.2 Sponsorship must not be used for unlawful activities or activities that may bring the charity into disrepute.

4. Branding and Publicity

- 4.1 Applicants must obtain written permission before using the charity's name, logo, or branding.
- 4.2 Where sponsorship is granted, the applicant agrees to acknowledge the charity's support in promotional materials where appropriate.
- 4.3 The charity may use the applicant's name, logo, and project information for promotional purposes.

5. Safeguarding and Compliance

- 5.1 Applicants working with children or vulnerable adults must have appropriate safeguarding policies in place.
- 5.2 Applicants must comply with all relevant UK laws and regulations, including but not limited to safeguarding, equality, and data protection legislation.

6. Monitoring and Reporting

- 6.1 Successful applicants may be required to provide progress updates or a final report outlining outcomes achieved.
- 6.2 Failure to provide requested information may affect future funding decisions.

7. Withdrawal or Repayment

7.1 The charity reserves the right to withdraw sponsorship at any time if:

- Information provided is found to be false or misleading
- Activities bring the charity into disrepute
- Terms and conditions are breached

8. Liability

8.1 The charity accepts no liability for any loss, damage, or injury arising from activities funded through sponsorship.

8.2 The applicant is responsible for obtaining appropriate insurance where required.

9. Data Protection

9.1 Personal data will be processed in accordance with applicable UK data protection legislation, including the UK GDPR and Data Protection Act 2018.

9.2 Information provided may be used for the purposes of assessing applications, monitoring activities, and future communications.

10. Decision Making

10.1 All decisions made by the charity regarding sponsorship are final.

10.2 The charity is not obliged to provide detailed feedback on unsuccessful applications.

11. Changes to Terms

11.1 The charity reserves the right to amend these terms and conditions at any time without prior notice.

12. Governing Law

12.1 These terms and conditions are governed by the laws of England and Wales.
